"A resurgent desire exists in homeowners to bring more warmth and character into their homes. Architectural firms have responded by integrating more natural surfaces, particularly wood, into their designs. Traditional woods like mahogany, maple and walnut are being used more prominently, and exotic selections such as amege, Brazilian cherry and lacewood are being introduced. Rather than restricting themselves to a singular wood within a home, designers are combining woods to provide accents and add visual interest. The usage of wood is expanding beyond simple flooring and doors to other applications including veneered paneled walls and ceiling trim detailing."
